This page presents the events that are triggered by eZ Publish 5.

eZ Publish Core

Event name	Triggered when...	Usage
<code>ezpublish.siteaccess</code>	After the SiteAccess matching has occurred.	Gives further control on the matched SiteAccess. The event listener method receives an <code>eZ\Publish\MVC\Event\PostSiteAccessMatchEvent</code> object.
<code>ezpublish.pre_content_view</code>	Right before a view is rendered for a content item, via the content view controller.	This event is triggered by the view manager and allows you to inject additional parameters to the content view template. The event listener method receives an <code>eZ\Publish\MVC\Event\PreContentViewEvent</code> object.
<code>ezpublish.api.contentException</code>	The API throws an exception that could not be caught internally (missing field type, internal error...).	This event allows further programmatic handling (like rendering a custom view) for the exception thrown. The event listener method receives an <code>eZ\Publish\MVC\Event\APIContentExceptionEvent</code> object.

eZ Publish Legacy

Event name	Triggered when...	Usage
<code>ezpublish_legacy.build_kernel_web_handler</code>	Right before the build of the legacy kernel web handler.	This event allows to inject parameters into the web handler (mainly for internal use) The event listener method receives an <code>eZ\Publish\Legacy\Event\PreBuildKernelWebHandlerEvent</code>
