Problem

What command-line do you have to use for using Composer?

Solution

In documentation you will find

```
$> php composer.phar <command>
```

and

```
$> composer <command>
```

You will use the command-line according to your installation.

	Locally	Globally
Command-line	\$> php composer.phar	\$> composer
Advantages	No rights needed No configuration needed (out of the box)	Every user on the server can access to composer CLI You have your Composer outside your web RootDirectory

Installation

Locally

```
curl -sS https://getcomposer.org/installer | php

or (according to your user rights on your system)

php -r "readfile('https://getcomposer.org/installer');" | php
```

Globally

```
curl -sS https://getcomposer.org/installer | php mv composer.phar
/usr/local/bin/composer
```
